

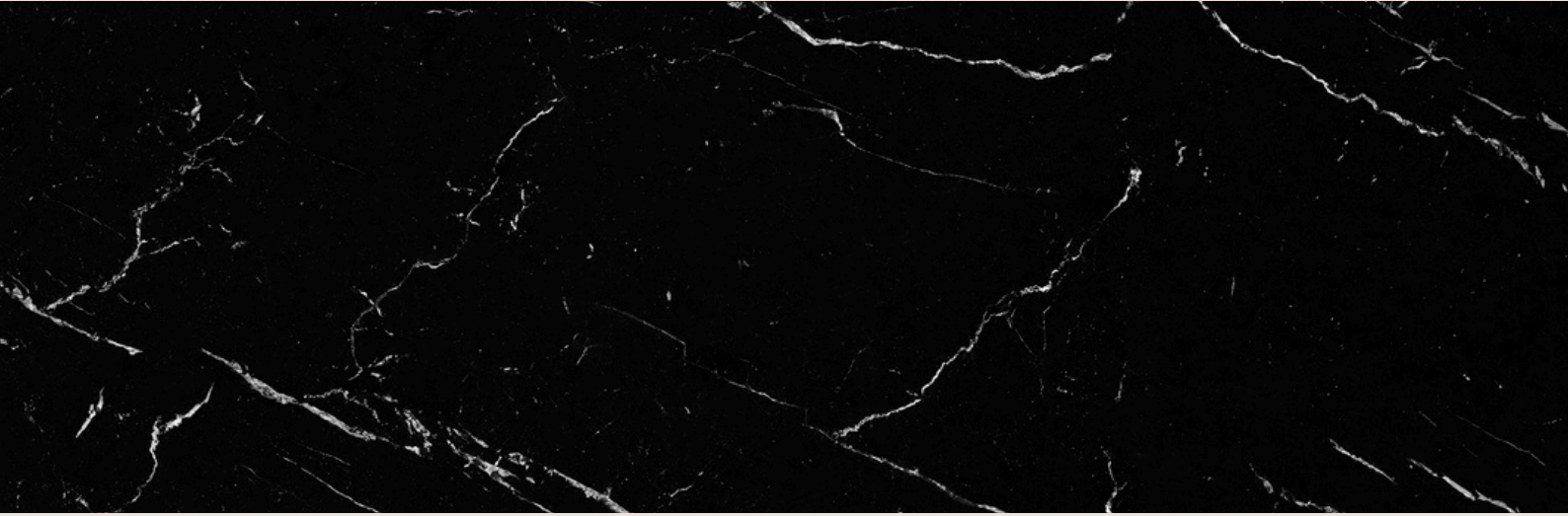

MARBLE

- While marble is durable, it is still porous and softer than ceramic or quartz, making it more susceptible to scratching and staining. To maintain its beauty, it's essential to seal marble periodically and clean spills promptly using a pH-neutral cleaner. We also recommend keeping sharp objects and acidic substances away from Your Marble surface :)
- With the right care, marble furniture can retain its timeless allure, aging gracefully and adding a touch of refined charm to your home. But always remember to respect the qualities of natural stone.

WHAT ABOUT QUARTZ?



QUARTZ

- Unlike natural stones, quartz is manufactured (man-made), allowing for a wide range of repeating colors and patterns, from subtle designs to bold statements.
- Quartz is an engineered stone crafted from natural quartz crystals combined with resins and pigments, resulting in a highly durable and consistent material.
- This process also makes quartz non-porous, significant advantage for surfaces exposed to spills and frequent use.
- Caring for quartz is simple—since it's non-porous, it doesn't need sealing, and a quick wipe keeps it looking fine :)

CERAMIC

- Ceramic is a man-made material crafted from natural clay and minerals, fired at high temperatures to create an incredibly dense and durable surface. Its creation process allows for nearly limitless design options, with colors, textures, and patterns that can mimic natural stone or even wood.
- Ceramic surfaces are typically non-porous and highly resistant to stains, scratches, and heat, making them ideal for dining tables, countertops, and other frequently used surfaces. Ceramic does not require any special care.
- Its amazing qualities and modern appearance make ceramic a stylish and practical choice for those who want a stunning, low-maintenance surface that can stand up to the demands of daily life.
